1st Women Wheelchair Basketball Competition was organized successfully on 2nd March, 2019 at Siphel Ground, Kathmandu by Rotary Club of Rudramati Kathmandu in coordination with Wheelchair Sports Association along with Rotaract club of Rudramati, Babarmahal and Manohara.

The competition held with the objective to promote sportsmanship culture among the differently able people was a huge success in terms of participation and observant.

There were 5 teams and knockout round system was held. Name of 5 teams are as follows:

- a) Women Wheelchair Basketball Association
- b) Buddhist in Action
- c) Wheelchair Sports Association
- d) Jawalakhel Sports Association
- e) Nepal Spinal Cord Injury Association

The Women Wheelchair Basketball Association (WWBA) secured the 1st position while Buddhist in Action (BIA) achieved second position and Wheelchair Sports Association (WSA) satisfied itself in the third position.

The winning teams were awarded with Rs. 10,000, Rs. 7000 and Rs. 5000 to first, second and third respectively along with trophy, medals and certificates. In addition, each Rs 3500 is provided to all the teams as token of appreciation. The event was inaugurated by Rtn. Ishu Subba President for Rotary Club of Rudramati in the presence of Rtn. Tulsi Maharjan from Rotary Club of Branchburg, Past District Governor Rotary District 7510 and Chair The Asha Project among many others. The guest of attraction during the closing ceremony and prize distribution was Former Nepalese Army General Chief of Army Staff Rukmangud Katawal.

The competition started from 11 am and went up to 5 pm in the evening where about 1000 people attended the program. Participants also performed cultural dance performance at the closing ceremony.
