Kiwi Farming Training for Income Generation

Three days training on 'Kiwi Farming for Income Generation' was conducted by RC Rudramati Kathmandu as a part of Global Grant entitled "Improving lives of local people of three villages in Nuwakot and Sindhupalchowk district". The international partner for the project is Rotary Club of Sant Rosa East and cooperating partner for the project is ICA Nepal. Kiwi Farming training was conducted with the technical support from ICIMOD Knowledge Park, Godawari on December 7, 2018 to the people of Digam, Chipling and Thankani. The main purpose of the training was to improve the financial situation of community people through Kiwi Farming as its demand is highly increasing in the market and provides a good money to the farmers too. The training was provided by Mr. Samden Lama Sherpa, Knowledge Park Officer of ICIMOD. Total 18 farmers directly benefitted from the training.

Major content covered: pitting and planting techniques, distance measurement between plant to plant and row to row for kiwi cultivation, manuring/watering techniques, trellis types and size, trellis and number of binding wire, training kiwi plants, and pruning and fruit selection.

An interaction program was also conducted for motivating farmers to practice cash crops and introduce diversity in their farming style.
